We enclose our manuscript, "Human Retrovirus, HTLV, Proviral DNA in Lymphocytes of Two Patients with Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome (AIDS)", for submission to Science. Please consider it for publication as a brief report. The paper reports the identification of human T-leukemia/lymphoma viral (HTLV) sequences in lymphocytes of patients with the acquired immune deficiency syndrome (AIDS).
